New Business

- Shawn McNealy moved to add committees/crews for judging and spot tractor
 - Same people
 - Bring the teams back
 - If there early, judge and spot early
 - If there late, judge and spot late
 - Jason Messer being a full time spot tractor operator
 - Do a better job overall
 - General agreement not to make committees/crews
- Aaron Mastin moved to pull 3 set of classes instead of 4 set of classes by pulling one at a time
 - \circ No seconded or vote
- Devon moved pull all same class set in one weekend
 - No seconded or vote
- Mike Mastin moved to amend rule #17 to continue add weight to the sled until 2 of the first 3 tractors cannot make 15ft full pull.
 - Aaron seconded
 - Motion passed
- Natalie moved to amend rule #17 to add "the first 2 of 3 hooks on second hooks would restart the class even if its not the first 3 pullers.
 - Devon second
 - \circ Motion passed
- Aaron Mastin moved to amend rule #17 to "The sled will be weighted to 220% of the class to begin the first round."
 - Pat Moran seconded
 - Motion passed
- Rule #17 now reads "The sled will be weighted to 220% of the class to begin the first round. If the first 2 out of 3 tractors that make a 15 ft. full pull on the 1st or 2nd attempts at the current weight, more weight will be added, the class will start the next round with the first tractor. This will be continued until 2 out of the first 3 tractors to make 2 attempts do NOT make a 15 ft. full pulls. At this time the current round all tractors will have the opportunity to hook to this weight. 1000 lbs. will be added each time on the "little" sled and 2000 lbs. will be added each time on the "little" sled and 2000 lbs. Will be added to the sled. If any of the first 3 tractors pass their 1st or 2nd attempts, then the next tractor to complete their attempts will be added to the 3 tractors of this rule. Revised 2024".

- Natalie moved to amend rule#12 to add measuring tape to measure 18ft to switch the direction of the lane.
 - \circ Jack seconded
 - Motion failed
 - \circ $\,$ Continue with step count and judge determination $\,$
 - If a measure is disputed the judge can bring a tape measure out.
- Darren Niehoff stated to have three different colors for the three different block weight for the sled be done at set up.
 - Little sled needs 1,200 lbs. to start
 - "Big" sled needs 18,500 lbs. to 19,000 lbs. to start
- Nate Moran moves to leave the classes at 4 sets of 30 mins intervals
 - o Nate Niehoff Seconded
 - Motion Passed
- Mike Yeley moved to amend Rule #39 "Pulling strictly begins at 9:00 AM with the first set of classes. The next set of classes will begin 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class of the previous set. The secretary will keep time."
 - Motion was never voted on, but the general group agreed to this change
- Set up sled
 - Set up through out the week when you can; weather permitting
 - Text Jack and he will send out message to group telling others people are going to set up, if they can help
 - Or if set up is completed Jack will let group know
- Devon Niehoff moved to start on July 13th, pull 6 weeks, and ending the weekend before Labor Day, August 24th.
 - Brady McNealy Seconded
 - Motion Passed
